OTT RULES

Use of Forward Facing Sonar is Prohibited. Forward Facing Sonar CANNOT be used at any time during Tournament hours. A transducer cover/lock will be provided for each event by the OTT and placed on the boat by a tournament official during morning boat inspections. The OTT may exclude using the transducer covers on some lakes where forward facing may not apply (shallower lakes)

1. **Teams:** All tournaments are Team Tournaments with a 5 fish limit. A Team is (2 anglers) but a team may compete with only one member during the season no more than one time during the season. An alternate may be used up to 2 times during the season w/ an alternate membership fee of \$25. An alternate may compete in the Championship if used for the maximum of 2 times, competing with the same team during the same season.

2. **Participation & Eligibility:** The field will consist of no more than 30 boats. The field size may increase in the future years with the circuit officer's approval. All teams will be approved by the officers prior to the start of the season. Participation is open

to anyone 18 years or older. Anyone under the age of 18 must be partnered with an adult over the age of 18
3. **Membership Fee's:** There is a \$50 annual membership per team. 4.

Entry Fee: Will consist of \$100 per event. There will also be a side pot of \$10 for Big Bass and another \$10 pot for a 12# pot. If the 12# pot is not broken at an event, it will carry over to the next event till the 12# weight is met. Total for each event with pots will be \$120.00

5. **Raffle Tickets:** Each team is required to sell a minimum of 20 (\$10) raffle tickets per year. All raffle sales go directly to the Championship fund. That's \$200 per team. Teams may sell more to help with our championship funding.

6. **Tournament Hours:** Tournament hours will be set with blast off at safe light but no sooner than 6:15 and 3:00 pm for check in.

7. **Registration & Boat Numbers:** Teams will have options on how they enter. All registration will begin at 5:00 am and close at 5:45 the morning of the event. Entries received the morning of the event will be given the first number in line after all Double Draws have been designated. Example: If 20 teams paid in advance and are eligible for the Double Draw, the next team registering will receive #21 etc.. The last team signing up will be the blast off boat.

8. **Points:** Points will be awarded based on a full field of 30 boats. The first place team will receive 30 points, 2nd 29, 3rd 28, etc...

9. **Boat Requirements:** All boats must be equipped with emergency kill switch. Kill switch must be attached to Boat Operator at all times while on plane. A US Coast Guard approved life jackets are required for each person in boat. Life jackets must be worn and fastened anytime the boat is on plane. All boats must have a properly functioning live well that is adequate to keep the tournament limit of bass alive.

10. **Method of Fishing:** All bass must be caught on artificial bait only. No trolling allowed with either the main motor or trolling motor. Contestant may use only one rod at any one time. Umbrella Rigs/Alabama Rigs are allowed with a maximum of three (3) hooks. All fish caught while "sight fishing" must be hooked inside the mouth. **Use of Forward Facing Sonar is Prohibited after 12:00AM the morning of The**

11. **Dead Fish Penalty:** Any dead bass weighed in will result in a deduction of one (8) ounces per dead fish applied to their daily weight. No more than 2 dead fish will be weighed for a daily limit. Big Bass must be alive in order to be eligible for the BB award.
12. **Minimum Length:** The minimum length limit will be set by the ODNR legal length per lake competition. The length will be announced at morning the meeting.

13. **Culling:** No team may possess more than the state bag limit at any time during the tournament. Culling must be completed prior to returning to the check in area.

14. **Ties:** A tie will be broken by the Big Bass. If tied after Big Bass is weighed, a tie will be resolved by combining the money/points from tied places and splitting it evenly between tied Teams.

15. **Permitted Fishing Areas:** Teams may fish anywhere on Tournament Waters by boat that is available to the public, except areas designated as "off limits" or "no fishing" by State or Federal Officials.

16. **Protests:** All protest must be submitted to the Tournament Director either verbally or in writing within fifteen (15) minutes of the closing of the scales. A protest will be heard by no less than 3 of the tournament officials. All decisions of the Tournament Director and Officials are final.

17. **Championship Qualification:** A team must compete in a minimum of 5 out of the 6 events, sell a minimum of 20 raffle tickets and pay the championship entry fee of \$100.

18. **Team Of The Year:** The Team of the Year will consist of the team with the most points after the 6th event is completed. The TOTY will be awarded their entry fee's (\$100 x 6) for the next year paid in full. All side pots are not included.

19. **Liability Insurance:** All teams must carry current liability insurance on the boat they are using while competing in any/all Outlaw Tournament Trail events.
