

- 1. All contestants must wear a Coast Guard approved vest or preserver when the gasoline motor is running (except when idling).
- 2. All state and local laws must be observed and obeyed.

RULES

- Only artificial lures, with exception of pork trailers, will be permitted. Trolling as a method of fishing is prohibited.
- 4. All boats must be equipped with some type of ignition kill switch. An aerated live wei or aerated container is mandatory. All boats must be propeller driven and must be 15° or more in length. No cumbersome craft allowed. At no time may a contestant leave the boat to land lish or make the boat more accessible to fishing waters. All fishing must be done from the boat. No stick steering allowed.
- Boat positions will be drawn at each Tournament site for each Tournament for the teams that mailed in their entry forms. All others will be assigned a position. Boat owners wilt be e-mailed confirmation of entry if time allows.
- 6. Fishing is permitted anywhere within the Tournament waters, or connecting waters accessible by boat during specified times, except that no contestant is allowed to fish within 50 yards of a public gas dock, the weigh in area and any area that has been designated a "no fishing" area by the governing body of the lake or river or the Tournament Director.
- All bass will be returned to the Tournament waters if found to be in good shape and expected to live.
- In case of ties in all Tournaments, contestants may split prize money or determine winning position by flip of coin.
- Fishing is not allowed within 50 yards of another competitor's boat which
 was first anchored. A boat is considered anchored only if it is tied to
 an object or has an anchor rope over its side with trolling motor out of
 water. Power poles are considered an anchor.
- 10. Contestants must leave and return to official check point by boat. In the event of equipment failure or emergency, there shall be two permitted methods of returning to the check-In. (1) By both partners remaining in their boat and being towed by water or (2) By one partner entering the boat of another Salmoides Tournament contestant with the days catch. Teams fish must be kept separate.
- Any participant cited during Tournament hours for a violation of state, marine or fishing laws will be disqualified.
- Any occurrence not covered by the rules will be governed by Tournament Directors.
- 13. Daily limit will be 5 bass per team, large mouth, small mouth or spotted bass. All bass must be of legal fimit in length. The 6th bass must be culled. Short fish will be penalized one lb, per short fish.
- One (1) Ib. from total weight of fish will be deducted for each minute the team is late and the team will be disqualified after five minutes.
- 15. A penalty of eight (8) ounces per dead fish will be deducted from total weight. All stringed or mangled fish will be rejected from team's catch. If Big Bass is dead, it will be deducted eight (8) ounces.
- 16. All contestants will be subject to random polygraph test and must take the test. Failure of the test or refusal is automatic disqualification.
- 17. A team must be formed before using an alternate partner.
- 18. You may fish by yourself at any tournament after you have formed a team. Each team is allowed to use two alternates per regular season. The alternate must be approved by tournament officials. Saimoides officials reserve the right to disallow the pairing. When fishing by yourself you are allowed 5 bass.
- Alternates will not be acceed to fish the Championship. If a team member is to fish without the original partner they may fish alone. The number of fish allowed will be 5 bass.
- 20. Practice days are open. You may bring observer.

21. All boats and live wells must be checked before start of Tournament.

2022 SALMOIDES TEAM TOURNAMENT CIRCUIT RULES

- 22. Boat registration will begin at 4:30 a.m. the moming of the Tournament. Pre-tournament meetings will be one half hour before each tournament. Tournament hours are 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. or safe light. At least one member of each team must attend the meeting. Salmoides officials reserve the right to interpret all rules when questioned.
- 23. Salmoldes reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry it receives.
- 24. All protests must be made within 10 minutes after weigh-in time.
- Violation of any of these rules may be cause for disqualification from this and all future Tournaments.
- Scoring will be 150 1st, 149 2nd, etc. Those teams who do not weigh in a bass will score 20 points less than last place to weigh fish.
- 27. A courtesy measuring board will be set up at each Tournament for your convenience. Please measure all fish before they come to the scales. Any fish that are doubtful of making the legal length will be measured. No official will man the courtesy board. Once the fish are taken at the weigh-in table, only Salmoides Officials will be allowed to handle the fish.
- Salmoides will accept entry and fees at the ramp. Late entries will be assigned boat position.
- 29. E-mail confirmation of each Tournament and special events will be sent to the boat owner on the entry form. It is then up to the boat owner to relay the information to the partner.
- 30. The team that has the most points at the end of the qualifying Tournaments in their division will have the title of 2022 Salmoides Division Points Champions and will receive free entries for the 2023 season.
- In case of a tie for points champions. It will be decided by total weight for the year. To qualify for the championship a team must fish all 5 tournaments in any one division.
- 32. Only one casting or spinning rod per individual (8 ft. maximum length from butt of handle to rod tip) and reel per individual may be used at any one time. All other types are prohibited. Other rods and reels as specified above may be in the boat ready for use. Only one is permitted in use at any time during the tournament. All bass must be caught alive in a sporting manner.
- 33. During tournament hours, cell phones or any other communication devices may be used for any purpose other than any information pertaining to largemouth, smallmouth, or Kentucky (spotted) Bass.
- 34. No stacking lish in any form. No penetrating cull systems allowed. If you use an alternate in the last tournament, you can not qualify for pt. champions.
